THE STORY OF THE FIRST TERRORIST MASSACRE IN THE HISTORY OF ISLĀM BY THE SAVAGES AND EVIL DOGS OF HELLFIRE, THE KHĀRIJITE RENEGADES

AND THE FREEDOM AND EXONERATION OF THE NOBLE PROPHET OF ISLĀM (مَا اللهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسَالًا) FROM THEM.

All praise is due to Allah, the Lord of the Worlds, the Lord of Noah, Abraham, Moses, Jesus and Muhammad. May the peace and blessings be upon them all. To proceed: The Salafi Scholar, Shaykh 'Ubayd al-Jābirī stated recently with respect to the killings at Charlie Hebdo in Paris, France, that the intelligent amongst the Jews, Christians and others who have lived side by side with Muslims know with certainty that there is no Muslim, whether a scholar, student or layman who venerates and follows the Prophetic Sunnah² except that he rejects these criminal actions irrespective of where they are perpetrated. This is known to all intelligent and reasonable people, including the major politicians of non-Muslim countries. The first and greatest victims of terrorism perpetrated in the name of Islām were not just any ordinary Muslims, but the best of all Muslims, the Companions of the Prophet Mūhammad (مَا أَلِلَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًا) himself.3

THE FIRST TERRORIST MASSACRE IN THE HISTORY OF ISLĀM

The Muslim historian Ibn al-Athīr (d. 630H) writes, "It is said that when the Khārijites turned towards the direction of al-Nahrawan from al-Basrah, they saw a group amongst whom was a man leading a woman on a donkey. They called out to him, both scolding and frightening him and said, 'Who are you?' He said, 'I am 'Abdullāh bin Khabbāb, the companion of the Messenger of Allāh (صَالِمَةُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالَمُ).' So they said to him, 'Have we frightened you?' He said, 'Yes.' They said, 'There is no need to be alarmed. Narrate to us a tradition from your father which you heard from the Messenger of Allāh (صَا اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًا) by which you can benefit us.' So he said, 'My father narrated to me from the Messenger of Allāh (مَا اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًا) that he said, 'There will be a tribulation in which the heart of a man will die just as his body dies. He will reach the evening as a believer and reach the morning as a disbeliever, and he will reach the morning as a disbeliever and reach the evening as a believer'.'

They said, 'It was this (very) tradition that we were asking you about, so what do you say about Abū Bakr and 'Umar?' He ('Abdullāh) praised them both. They said, 'What do you say about 'Uthmān at the beginning of his leadership?' He said, 'He was correct in both its beginning and its end.' They said, 'What do you say about 'Alī before the arbitration and after it?' He said, 'He ('Alī) was more knowledgeable of Allāh than you, more severely cautious in his religion and more penetrative in insight (than you).' They said, 'You follow (your) whims and you give loyalty to men due to their titles and not due to their actions.⁴ By Allāh we will slaughter you with a slaughtering by which we have not yet slaughtered anyone.'

THE FALSE PIETY AND EVIL TREACHERY OF THE KHĀRIJITES

Then they took him, tied his hands up and led both him and his woman - and she was at the peak of her pregnancy - until they stopped under some date-palm trees. A ripe date fell from the tree and one of them took it and left it in his mouth. Another one (amongst them) said,'You took that without it being lawful and without paying a price for it.' So he threw it out. Then they passed by a pig belonging to one of the people of the covenant (a Christian) and one of them struck it with his sword. They (the others) said, 'This amounts to causing corruption upon the Earth.' So he met with the owner of the pig and gave him compensation for it. When 'Abdullah bin Khabbab saw this (apparent piety) from them, he said, "If you are truthful in what I see from you, then I should have no reason to fear from your harm. I am a Muslim, I have not innovated anything into Islām, you gave me security when you said, 'You have no reason to fear'.'

BRAINLESS SAVAGES AND DEPRAVED DOGS SPILL INNOCENT BLOOD AND KILL WOMEN

At this point they forced him to lie on his side and slaughtered him and his blood flowed into the water. Then they turned to the woman and she said, 'I am a woman, will you not fear Allāh!' But they cut open her stomach (killing her) and killed three other women. They also killed Umm Sinān al-Ṣaydāwiyah. When their killing of 'Abdullāh bin Khabbāb and their abuse of the people reached 'Alī, he sent al-Hārith bin Marrah al-'Abdī to them to observe them, to see what would reach him about them and (for al-Hārith) to write to him and not conceal anything about them. But when he (reached) and got close to them to ask them (about their affair), they killed him. The news of this came to 'Alī whilst the people were with him and they said, 'O Chief of the Believers. How long shall we leave those to remain behind us to succeed over our families and wealth? Lead us to these people so that when we have finished with them we can proceed to our opponents

from the people of Shām (Syria)'." End quote from Ibn al-Athīr.5

It was here that 'Alī (المُؤَلِّلُةُ and the Companions with him proceeded to fight and kill the Khārijites and this action was counted from the many virtues of 'Alī, the son-in-law of the Prophet Muhammad (مَا أَلِثُكُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَمٌ). The continued presence of these terrorists until the end of time was prophesized by Muhammad (صَا لِللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالَم). 'Abdullāh bin 'Umar (وَعَوْلَلُهُونَةُ) related that the Prophet (مَا أَلِتُهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) said, "A group will emerge who recite the Qur'an but it does not go beyond their throats. Every time a faction amongst them emerges it will be cut off. Every time a faction amongst them emerges it will be cut off, until the Dajjāl (Anti-Christ) appears amongst their armies." Some of the Muslim scholars have explained that the Khārijite terrorists will be with the Dajjāl and he will be with them.⁷

THE KHĀRIJITES ARE MOTIVATED BY MATERIAL WORLDLY AFFAIRS AND NOT RELIGION

Just as the Prophet (مَيَّالِسَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّةٍ) informed, these people emerged without even thirty years having passed after his death and they wreaked havoc upon the Muslim nation, leading to mass slaughter and splitting. Their statement of doctrine appeared in relation to matters of wealth and rulership, and this is what they are motivated by, not religion. All their speech is about politics, rulers and wealth and Islam is merely a hijacked vehicle. These Khārijite factions continued to appear in every century, assaulting the main Muslim body, until this time of ours when they were given a breath of life through the activities of Hasan al-Bannā, founder of the group of the Muslim Brotherhood, and Sayyid Qutb, the ideological father of all contemporary takfīrī and jihādī movements. Sayyid Qutb spread the evil doctrine that all Muslim societies are apostate

societies against whom a large-scale jihād is obligatory and must be waged to cleanse the Muslim lands as he claimed. It is from the greatest of injustice that the Prophet of Islām (مَا اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًة) is judged and tarnished through the actions of these evil people about whom he himself said, "If I was to reach them, I would slaughter them like the slaughtering of $\bar{A}d$ (a destroyed nation of the past)."8 Islām and the teachings of the Prophet are antithetical to what the Khārijite terrorists stand for.

THE PROPHET (مَوَالْتَهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًا) IS ABOVE WHAT IS ASCRIBED TO HIM AND CARTOONS FOUNDED UPON LIES DO NOT HARM HIM

Allāh (عَنْهَا) said, "And we have made lofty your mention." (94:4).9 And He also said. "Then declare what you are commanded (to convey) and turn away from the polytheists. Indeed, We are sufficient for you against the mockers" (15:94-95). It is engraved in history that the Prophet (مَا اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًا) never, ever initiated any violence against his opponents and was commanded to endure patience whilst preaching peacefully. After suffering thirteen years of enmity and abuse, he and many of his companions were forced to emigrate to what became the city of al-Madīnah where the plots and schemes of their enemies continued unabated. Permission was eventually granted for the Muslims to defend themselves. Many of these factions had treacherously broken their covenants which had been initiated and entered into by the Muslims to maintain peace in the society at large. The Muslims only partook in fighting due to prior aggression against them and the unscrupulous violation of treaties and agreements by their aggressors. The Companions of the Prophet were victims of terrorism in both the Makkan period of Islām - a fact conveniently omitted from the history books by

Islamophobic haters like Robert Spencer so that they can forge lies against Islām and its noble and lofty Prophet (صَالِتَهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًم) - and in the Madinan period. Just as they were also victims of terrorism after the death of the Prophet (مَا لِللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَالًا). They were the first to suffer at the hands of the most despicable and evil of creation, the Khārijite renegades, and the Muslims continued to suffer at their hands after them. Many reputable scholars, past and present, consider these Khārijite renegates to be apostates from Islām due to their making lawful what the Islāmic Sharī ah has made unlawful of shedding blood that is inviolable in the Sharī ah, whether Muslim or non-Muslim blood. All intelligent, honest and reasonable people who are well-read in history will recognize the great lie upon which the noble, honourable, lofty Semitic Prophet of Islām is slandered and mocked in the name of the alleged freedom of speech - a veil of hypocrisy used by extreme liberalists to justify the violation of sanctities, provocation and the spewing of hatred.¹⁰ The Prophet of Islām (مَا ٱللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَاءً) is free from the extremist terrorists. The terrorists are free of Islām. And Islām and its Prophet are free from the lies of every resentful liar.
